

The scoring system

The wines in this show were judged according to a standard assessment system where Appearance, Nose and Palate are allocated a maximum of 3, 7 and 10 points respectively, making a total maximum point score of 20 for each wine. Scores nominated by the three judges are then added together to produce the overall score (maximum 60 points). Scores are listed in the results for medal winners only. Exhibitors will be notified regarding the scores of nominated wines not listed in the results.

Medals are awarded based on the overall score, as per the schedule below.

Gold Medal	55.5 - 60.0
Silver Medal	51.0 - 55.4
Bronze Medal	46.5 - 50.9

Most successful exhibitor is determined from an aggregate score based on total medal count (Gold=5, Silver=3, Bronze=1)
